Externally there is a paved driveway to the front leading to the attached garage. There is also a charming split-level garden to the rear with a patio area and stairs leading to a lawn.

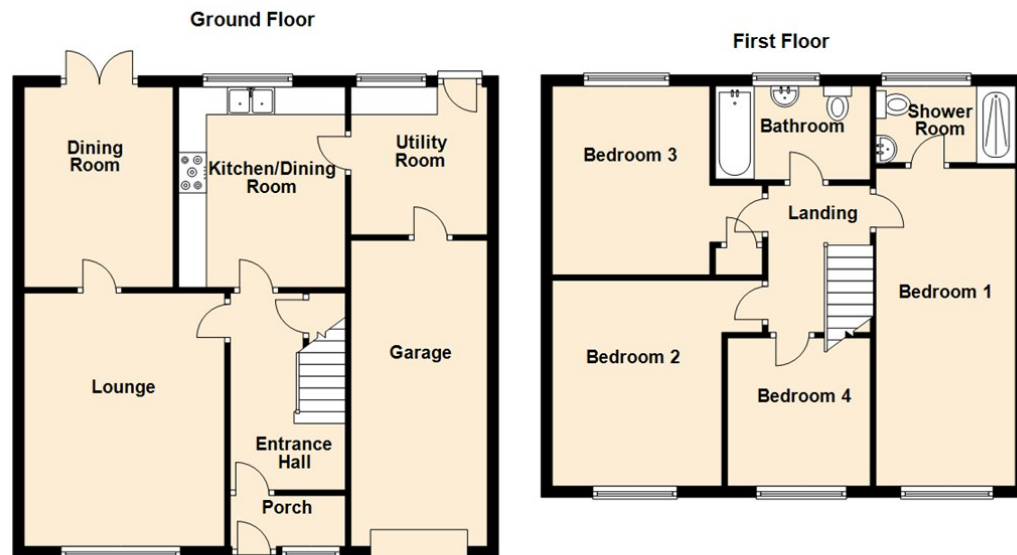
